Funding Guidelines for Sanford Grants Spring 2018 RFP

The Spring 2018 Request for Proposals (RFP) process will award grants that both add new partners and that create greater impact with existing partners. Grant applications will be accepted on a rolling basis throughout the year through an online application system. Applications will be reviewed by a grant selection committee on a quarterly basis. The following funding opportunities are available:

New Inspire partnerships	Postsecondary institutions	\$25,000 to \$100,000
Renewal of current Inspire partnerships	Postsecondary institutions	\$15,000 to \$75,000

SANFORD INSTITUTE OF PHILANTHROPY	<i>Eligible grant partners</i>	<i>Min to max funding (one year)</i>
New Philanthropy affiliates	Postsecondary institutions, non-profit, and community-based organizations	\$25,000 to \$100,000
Capacity building grants for current Philanthropy partnerships	Postsecondary institutions, non-profit, and community-based organizations	\$15,000 to \$75,000
